# OVEN AND HOT PLATE CLEANER

A heavy duty alkaline cleaner formulated to remove baked deposits from ovens, grills, hot plates, etc. It has embodied a highly concentrated blend of hydroxides, wetting agents, emulsifiers and special solvents for the removal of grease and heavy carbon deposits.

### ◆ DIRECTIONS:

Use neat or diluted down to as low as 250ml Oven & Hot Plate Cleaner per Litre of water. Will clean cold but if the surface is warm (not hot) cleaning will be much quicker.

Apply to surface using a cloth or carefully spray with a trigger sprayer set to "Squirt" rather than "Spray" and spread evenly over the surface with a cloth. Wear rubber gloves and eye protection as this product is corrosive. Allow product to soak for approx 1-5 minutes before washing or sponging away with water.

**Note:** Do not apply to aluminium oven trays or fittings, electric elements, wiring, etc as they may be damaged.

### ◆ BIODEGRADABLE:

The surfactants in this product are biodegradable according to internationally accepted criteria.

### ◆ PRESENTATION:

Available in 1 and 5 litre containers

### ◆ HAZARDS:

Corrosive Material. (Contains Caustic Soda). Avoid contact with skin or eyes. Harmful if swallowed. Keep out of reach of children.

### ◆ FIRST AID:

If swallowed: Do NOT induce vomiting. Rinse mouth with water. Give water to drink to achieve dilution. Immediately call a POISON CENTRE or doctor/physician.

In case of eye contact: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present. Continue rinsing. Immediately call a POISON CENTRE or doctor/physician.
